ENTRY FEE: \$90 one event; \$100 two events; \$110 three events
Boys & Girls 1 & 2 -- \$50 one event; \$60 two events; \$70 three events

SPECIAL ENTRY INFO:

- a) Skiers may use the standard AWSA Entry Form for tournament entry.
- b) All skiers must complete and submit a Skier's Biography form to be entered. Use the standard bio form from the Regional Guide.
- c) All skiers must present proof of AWSA membership before or at registration check-in to be entered in the tournament. No advance proof of qualification need be sent.
- d) Tournament entries not accompanied by check or money order for the correct entry amount will be rejected.
- e) All of the above may be submitted by mail prior to arrival at site. Upon arrival at site, please check bulletin board at registration to see what items are incomplete for your entry. IF ALL INFORMATION IS PROPERLY SUBMITTED IN ADVANCE, and registration is shown as complete, no further check-in will be required.

DEADLINE: July 24 (Friday prior to tournament). Entry AND payment must be RECEIVED before midnight, July 24, to avoid late fees. Entries will be confirmed by e-mail (entry must include e-mail address of skier) or by return (prepaid) receipt.

LATE FEE: \$20 per 24-hour period late.

ABSOLUTE DEADLINE: July 29th @ 4 PM (no entries accepted after this date).

RANKINGS REQUIRED: Refer to 2009 Regional Guide for required rankings for entry. The rankings list to be used for Regionals qualification and seeding will be the rolling 12-month list.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE: From Nashville (TN), go west on I-24 to (KY) Exit 11, Husband Road exit (2nd Paducah exit); at bottom of ramp, go left (south) on Husband Road ½ mile to Lydon Road; go left on Lydon Road exactly 2 miles to stop sign at Oaks Road; go left on Oaks Road ¾ mile to Hunter Lane, which is the entrance to Twin Oaks Lakes.

AIRPORTS: Grow Airfield (formerly Farrington Field), private planes, 3 miles; Barkley (Paducah) Regional, (served by Northwest Airlink), 15 miles; Nashville International, 130 mi.

HEADQUARTERS MOTELS: Drury Inn, Drury Suites, Pear Tree Inn and Thrifty Inn; special skier rates from \$54 (Thrifty) to \$94 (Drury Suites), depending on motel; flat rates for 1 to 4 persons per room; all officials will be booked at the Drury Suites; all motels are at Exit 4, approximately 10 minutes from the site. Call the local motel direct (see adjacent ad for phone numbers) to receive skier rates, and reference "Water Ski Tournament" when making reservations. Skier rates are GUARANTEED by the Drury Group/Paducah to be the "best available" rates for the chosen motel.

CAMPING: Camping on site, with electric hook-ups and shower facilities; \$18 per night (\$25 with electric). Adequate facilities for all campers. Reservations must be made in advance -- phone (270) 898-4250.

CONCESSIONS: Full service concessions will be available on site at all times; excellent variety, including the usual hamburgers/hot dogs/drinks, plus BBQ, specialty sandwiches, full breakfast menu. Will serve from 1/2 hour before start until 3 PM each day.

TOWBOATS: As determined by AWSA and the Southern Region.

AWARDS: 1st - 5th, all Boys and Girls divisions
1st - 5th, all other events with 15 or more skiers (1st - 3rd if less than 15 skiers)
1st - 3rd Overall, all divisions.
The standardized Southern Region medallions will be awarded for individual event placements, with overall trophies to be of a different design.

PRACTICE: Practice will be continuously available at the site beginning Tuesday at noon, but subject to site preparation and tech controller limitations. \$20 per pull (4 slalom passes, 3 jumps, 10 min. tricks).

OFFICIAL'S MEETING: Wednesday, 8 PM at the Drury Suites (appetizers & refreshments)

REGIONAL COUNCIL & GEN'L MEMBERSHIP MEETING: Thursday, 8 PM at the Drury Suites.

MASTERCRAFT JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT & AWARDS BANQUET: Friday, 7:30 PM, or one hour after completion of last event, whichever is later, at the Carson Special Events Center in downtown Paducah; buffet-style meal includes salad, 3 entrees, variety of vegetables, drinks, and desserts -- \$25. Banquet is free to all junior skiers; otherwise not included in entry fee.

NOTICE TO ALL SKIERS: Regional medical excuses will be evaluated by the Executive Vice President (Gene Davis), and only at the site. Check current edition of the Rules Book concerning medical excuses and out of region skier rules.

PROOF OF QUALIFICATION: Qualification will be established by Registrar at registration check-in. No paperwork needs to be submitted.

REGISTRATION and CHECK-IN: Registration will be open from 12 Noon to 5 PM on Wednesday (July 22), and from 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM Thursday through Saturday.

NOTE: All dogs and other pets must ABSOLUTELY BE KEPT ON LEASH. Owners not adhering to this mandate will be asked to remove their pet to a boarding kennel approximately five miles from the site (rates are typically \$20 per 24-hr period).

Operation of all four wheelers and other similar RV's are subject to the regulations of the Twin Oaks Lakes LOA, and the local management reserves the right to confiscate the keys of any vehicle not operated in a safe manner. ABSOLUTELY no underage operators.
